1. Overview of Quarter Operating Results

During the current first quarter consolidated cumulative period (from July 1, 2025 to September 30, 2025), Japan's economy showed signs of recovery, including increased personal consumption driven by higher wages and the deteriorated yen sparking a rise in inbound tourism. Factors such as the ruling party's loss of its majority in the election for the House of Councillors, however, contribute to rendering the economic outlook uncertain going forward.

Under these circumstances, our group aims to transform its business model in line with the changes in the environment and continue to grow as an on-premise infrastructure integrator.

Effective July 1, 2025, starting from the current first quarter consolidated cumulative period, the Company reorganized its operational structure from a business-based to a region-based system. This has resulted in a revision in the reportable segment classification method, with the Home-Use Business and Business-Use Business segments being consolidated and renamed the Network Solutions business segment.

In the Network Solutions business, the number of installations in rental properties has been steady, while sales of cross-selling products including network cameras are trending upward. Sales in the targeted medical and nursing care area, however, are currently flagging.

Meanwhile, profit margins have been declining because the number of outright sales projects continues to increase and there were no sales for large-scale, high-profit-margin projects.

As a result of the above, the Network Solutions business had sales of 3,141 million yen (up 3.0% from the same period last year) and segment profit of 673 million yen (down 9.2% from the same period last year).

In the Real Estate Business, FG Smart Asset Co., Ltd. had one real estate sale.

As a result of the above, the Real Estate Business had sales of 296 million yen (4 million yen in the same period last year) and a segment profit of 26 million yen (segment profit of 0 million yen in the same period last year).

Looking at other businesses, the Company recorded revenue generated from the Renewable Energy (electricity) Business and related activities at Off Grid Lab Co., Ltd. and Power Denki Innovation Inc., which became a subsidiary of Off Grid Lab. Moreover, various expenses related to the expansion of our Renewable Energy (electricity) Business are trending upward.

As a result of the above, other businesses had sales of 19 million yen (0 million yen in the same period last year) and a segment loss of 42 million yen (segment loss of 7 million yen in the same period last year).

As a result, the business results for the current first quarter consolidated cumulative period were sales of 3,463 million yen (up 13.4% from the same period last year), operating profit of 413 million yen (down 10.7% from the same period last year), ordinary profit of 409 million yen (down 10.8% from the same period last year), and profit attributable to owners of parent of 288 million yen (down 7.1% from the same period last year).

Total assets at the end of the current first quarter consolidated cumulative period were 13,158 million yen, an increase of 1,013 million yen compared with the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. This was due to an increase of 1,073 million yen in current assets, despite a decrease of 59 million yen in fixed assets.

The increase in current assets was mainly due to increases of 556 million yen in cash and deposits, 124 million yen in accounts receivable and contract assets, and 225 million yen in power generation assets held for sale. The decrease in fixed assets was due to a decrease of 86 million yen in communications equipment used to provide our communications services and a decrease of 30 million yen in deferred tax assets. (Liabilities)

Liabilities increased by 1,043 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year to 6,685 million yen. This was mainly due to increases of 844 million yen in short-term borrowings and 352 million yen in long-term borrowings (including repayments within one year), offsetting decreases of 89 million yen in contract liabilities and 83 million yen in income taxes payable.

(Net A sects)

Net assets decreased by 30 million yen from the end of the previous fiscal year to 6,472 million yen. This was mainly due to a 33 million yen decrease in non-controlling interests, despite a 14 million yen increase in retained earnings.

(3) Explanation of forward-looking information such as consolidated earnings forecasts

Regarding the consolidated earnings forecasts for the fiscal year ending June 2026, there is no change to the consolidated earnings forecasts stated in the "Consolidated Financial Results for the Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2025 (Under Japanese GAAP)" announced on August 14, 2025.

We will continue to examine the outlook for the future, and if it becomes necessary to revise the consolidated earnings forecasts, we will promptly disclose it.
